When you get to church Sunday, you'll find a 3x5 card in your bulletin, and more will be in the pews if you need more. Please write down your resolution on the card, and then put it in the collection plate. Please find a few ideas below to spark your imagination:

- Turn off unused lights. Put outside lights on timers or motion detectors
- Reduce your incandescent bulbs with LEDs
- Turn your thermostat down a degree or two in the winter, and up in the summer
- Plant a tree or bushes; help the earth's ability to convert CO2 to oxygen
- Use sunlight for passive heating--open and close shades and blinds to complement inside temps
- Use solar panels to recharge batteries and power outside lights
- Get active with environmental groups
