We heard from Sandy Wood, Shannon Abbott, and Jose Antonio's grandmother (thanks to Cassidy Hall's documentary) about the injustice of the tragic conditions that lead to children being killed at the border. We heard a powerful poem read by Olivia Bradley about our deep fears of immigrants, the fears that lead to the killing of children. We heard songs of hope offered by Sean Baker and Shannon.

We prayed for justice. We gave thanks for the witness of mercy and compassion at the border, acts of grace in the form of water in the desert and medical care for those in need. Upon the wishes of the family, we will continue to hold vigil until there is justice for Jose Antonio. The next vigil will be on March 10th at 6:30 p.m. at Broadway United Methodist Church.
