1 Samuel 2:1-10

Then Hannah prayed:

My heart delights in God,

to God I lift my horn high. I gloat over my foes,

I rejoice in your deliverance! There is no one holier than you. No one is holier than God; there is no Rock like God. All bragging must cease. Boastful arrogance must come to an end. For God is all-knowing,

and weighs all mortal deeds. The bows of warriors are broken,

while mothers of many are forsaken. It is God who deals out both life and death;

wealthy. It is God who both humbles and exalts. God lifts the weak from the refuse dump and raises the poor from the cesspool,
