
Today's Scripture

Luke 4:1-13

Jesus returned from the Jordan filled with the Holy Spirit, and she led him into the desert for forty days, where he was tempted by the devil. Jesus ate nothing during that time, at the end of which he was famished. The devil said to Jesus, "If you are God's own, command this stone to turn into bread." Jesus answered, "Scripture has it, 'we don't live on bread alone.'" Then the devil took Jesus up higher and showed him all the nations of the world in a single instant.
