¹ YHWH, you are my shepherd—I want nothing more. ² You let me lie down in green meadows; you lead me beside restful waters: ³ you refresh my soul. You guide me to lush pastures for the sake of your Name. 4 Even if I'm surrounded by shadows of Death, I fear no danger, for you are with me.
