Zoom Vespers on Tuesdays from 7:00 - 7:30 p.m.



Lenten Lunch and Learn Update — See You Next Wednesday!

This week we examined what it means to "do battle" in our own lives. We considered the stories of Jesus and Sonia and the ways in which we can learn from them for our own battles and the battles within our collective lives. We asked:

mow can we pray for those about to do pattle? Who when I know God is in the with at this time in your life? What does it look/feel like when I know God is in the battle with me? Our time concluded learning about the Yoruba, one of the largest African ethnic groups south of the Sahara Desert. We learned of how the Yoruba inspired the language of Sonia and the ways in which she utilizes texture and rhythm in her work. Finally, we gathered our own individual rhythms and created a unified rhythm by reading Sonia's poem Aaaayeee Babo (Praise God), which can be found here: https://www.splitthisrock.org/poetry-database/poem/aaaayeee-babo-praise-god

Have you ever been introduced to the Yoruba language and/or any traditions from the continent of Africa? Have you ever seen a map of the continent of Africa? How many countries can you identify on a map of Africa?
