2 Thessalonians 2:1-5, 13-17 1-5

Concerning the coming of Jesus Christ and our being gathered to meet our Savior: we beg you, sisters and brothers, don't become easily agitated or disturbed by some prophecy, report or letter falsely attributed to us, which says that the day of our Sayior has come. Let no one deceive you, in any way. It cannot happen until the Great Falling Away occurs, and the rebel, the Lost One, has appeared.

This is the Enemy, the one who claims to be so much greater than all that people call "God," greater than every object of worship—so much so that it enthrones itself in God's sanctuary and claims to be God. Surely you remember me telling you these things when I was with you?


