Isaiah 35: 1-10

Let the desert and the wilderness exult! Let the Arabah rejoice and bloom like the crocus! Let it blossom profusely,

let it rejoice and sing for joy!

The glory of Lebanon is bestowed on it,

the splendor of Carmel and Sharon. They will see the glory of YHWH,

the splendor of our God. Strengthen all weary hands,
