The congregation speaks antiphonally - right side, then left side

(R) O God, have mercy on me!

Because of your love and your compassion, wipe away my faults;

- (L) wash me clean of my guilt; purify me of my sin!
- (R) For I am aware of my faults, and have my sin constantly in mind.
- (L) I sinned against you alone, and did what is evil in your sight.
- (R) You are just when you pass sentence on me, Blameless when you give judgment.
- (L) I was born in guilt, in sin, conceived in sin—
- (R) yet you want truth to live in my innermost being. Teach me your wisdom!
- (L) Purify me with hyssop until I am clean; wash me until I am purer than new-fallen snow.
- (R) Instill some joy and gladness into me; let the bones you have crushed rejoice again.
- (L) Turn your face from my sins, and wipe out all my guilt.
- (R) O God, create a clean heart in me, put into me a new and steadfast spirit;
- (L) do not banish me from your presence, do not deprive me of your holy spirit!
- (R) Be my savior again, renew my joy, keep my spirit steady and willing.
- (L) and I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.
- (R) Save me from bloodshed, O God, of my salvation—

and my tongue will proclaim your justice.

(L) Open my lips, YHWH,
