## **Today's Scripture**

#### 1 John 4:7-21

Beloved.

let us love one another

because love is of God;

everyone who loves is begotten of God

and has knowledge of God.

Those who do not love have known nothing of God.

for God is love.

God's love was revealed in our midst in this way:

by sending the Only Begotten into the world, that we might have faith through the Anointed One.

Love, then, consists in this:

not that we have loved God.

but that God has loved us

and has sent the Only Begotten

to be an offering for our sins.

Beloved.

if God has loved us so.

we must have the same love for one another.

No one has ever seen God.

Yet if we love one another,

God dwells in us,

and God's love is brought to perfection in us.

#### John 15:1-8

"I am the true vine,

and my Abba is the vine grower

who cuts off every branch in me that doesn't

bear

fruit, but prunes the fruitful ones

to increase their yield.

You've been pruned already,

thanks to the word that I have spoken to you.
