Food Donations to Northside Pantry – Help those with hunger insecurity by bringing donations of canned or boxed food, and place in the baskets in the Narthex.


Cards to Our Church Family – Please sign the cards on our "card stand", for those celebrating birthdays, or in need of prayers.
