

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE

1 Timothy 2:1-7

First of all, I urge that prayers be offered for everyone—petitions, intercessions and thanksgivings—and especially for rulers and those in authority, so that we may be able to live godly and reverent lives in peace and quiet. To do this is right, and will please God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to reach full knowledge of the truth. Because of this I have been appointed to be a preacher, an apostle, and—this is the truth, now, I'm not lying—a faithful and honest teacher to the Gentiles.
